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CHAPTER 18

# THE PROTOPLASM ENTITY (PE)

Protoplasm is the living being on the lowest level. [*The Origin Nature and Evolution of Protoplasmic Individuals and Their Associations*, By Faustino Cordon, Pergamon Press, Oxford and New York, 1982, p. 133]

In opening out the timeline with a bandsaw, as we do with Hypnoetics™ and Supernoetics™ piloting, we of course encounter numerous past lives. Regardless of whether you believe in reincarnation or not, these memories arise. But we encounter an added dimension to this complexity. There is a biological “being” or entity, derived from the protoplasm line. We call this the *Protoplasm Entity (PE)*. It also has memory and it has a real case. The PE also has “past lives”, or a timeline of its own. These protoplasm memories also influences the Complex Of Self, specifically what I have referred to here as the “creature” self.

I’m going beyond just body memory now, into fascinating new realms, only lately explored by me. Any half decent memory worker/therapist/counselor (yes, there are some!) knows that stress and trauma are visited on the body. Any unresolved misery or psychic trauma can result in physical symptoms: aches and pains; actual disease processes; masses; sensations; strange subjective feelings and even deformity.

I’m now talking IMPACT: actual force impinged in the body, but not from violence—from psychic injury.

This genetic being is not entirely physical. Or more exactly, let me say that it is an information field imprint. It manifests in the physical.

Homeopaths would be familiar with this principle, as so-called miasms; a sort of shadow or imprint on the genetic line. It’s not in the genes or even the epigenes. It’s not even physical (see below).

You might wonder how it is transferred from organism to organism, generation to generation. Even if it was a physical imprint, it would have to pass through the zygote—the initial fusion of the male and female halves or “gametes”, which come together at conception.

That’s the equivalent to a one-cell organism and, remarkable though it seems, people have been able to recall that moment—the “conception dream”, as it’s called—so memory is operating in some form or other, even at this very early moment.

We don’t know how this memory transfer takes place is the honest answer. Non-physical doesn’t mean it isn’t there and doesn’t happen. It just means there is no “stuff” or matter version of the memory.

In fact that doesn't entirely rule out a physical transfer. Consider the holograph model. Most people think of the 3-D property of a hologram. But the really important characteristic of a hologram is that if you divide it in half, you don't end up with two half picture. You end up with two smaller entire (whole) pictures.

If you cut these smaller pictures in half, you end up with four complete pictures; then eight; then sixteen and so on, to infinity.

Of course these smaller and smaller images get fainter and fainter but each is nonetheless complete. So—the reasoning goes—the code for the entire cosmos is present in your fingernail or a pimple at the end of your nose!

Holographic memory then would be a small trace that holds all the information in question. If the universe is truly a hologram (which is widely accepted, though far from proven), then ancestral memories could pass through the tiny zygote single-cell phase complete and entire.

## **THE THETA LINE VS. THE PROTOPLASM LINE**

Let's clarify the differences here. Basically, the theta being is free to come and go whenever and wherever it wishes. We encounter beings with past lives in different times and places, as different genders, sometimes as animals or objects (not just living creatures), and from countless other worlds, dimensions and universes. Basically, a theta being can consider itself to be anywhere in creation and thus that's where it is.

The protoplasm line, however, isn't so free. Each protoplasm entity must come from a prior protoplasm entity: the progenitor. By definition it will inhabit the same or similar places, not far apart geographically and immediately sequential in time.

The theta being could be an earthly monk in one lifetime, a Babylonian whose the next, and captain of a silver spaceship somewhere in the Arcturus system after that. Let your imagination run wild.

Whereas the protoplasm line will be (say) Italian aristocracy for several generations, maybe with a painter thrown in; then Italian peasantry, after that, for several more generations; a count of Austrian descent, after the invasion of Lombardy; the daughter of a Milan industrialist and now a university undergraduate in Rome. Get the idea?

## VIKING MEMORY

I like sharing the following example: for many years (decades) I had a completely stuck picture of a wild scene in northern Europe, around the tenth century. The whole scene had a very Viking feel.

I was sitting on a clifftop, holding upright a massive sword, waiting; the Sun was setting to the west in a rage of blood-red light. Clearly, there was going to be an encounter and it was not going to be good!

I tried every way to date this picture, get some truth, that would make it vanish. It stuck fast.

Then—Duh!—one day I remembered my Viking ancestry. The name Mumby is a Norse name. A whole longboat full of Mumbys rowed across from Denmark to what is now England in the 10th century, landed on a small strip of beach and founded a village which, to this day, is called Mumby (7 miles north of the coastal town of Skegness). Over a thousand years later, all my father's family came from within fifty miles of this village.

Of course, I get it! This memory was not “mine”, which is why I could get rid of it (wrong ownership). It belonged to the Protoplasm Entity. I was able to reason that whatever this “encounter” was, my ancestor must have been the winner, and gone on to spread his seed, otherwise I would not have been here!

Anyway, spotting the truth caused this wild image to become evanescent and I have not been able to recall it since, except as a memory of a memory.

## THE HEART'S CODE

You may have heard of extraordinary cases in which organ transplant cases have taken on memories from the donor. That's memories from the PE, of course.

One of the most memorable was an American woman named Claire Sylvia, who received a new heart at a hospital in Yale, Connecticut. She was told that her donor was an eighteen year-old male from Maine, USA who had just died in a motorcycle accident.

Soon after the operation, Sylvia declared that she felt like drinking beer, something she hadn't particularly been fond of. Later, she observed an uncontrollable urge to eat chicken nuggets and found herself drawn to visiting the popular chicken restaurant chain, KFC. She also began craving green peppers which she hadn't particularly liked before.

It emerged in due course that the heart donor used to love chicken nuggets, green peppers and beer. [Sylvia, Claire. *A Change of Heart: a memoir*. New York; Warner Books, 1997].

The celebrated book *The Heart's Code* by Paul Pearsall MD, describes the stories of seventy-three heart transplant patients, and sixty-seven other organ transplant recipients.

One of the most striking examples, was that of an eight year-old girl, who received the heart of a murdered ten year-old girl, and began having recurring vivid nightmares about the murder. Her mother arranged a consultation with a psychiatrist who after several sessions concluded that she was witnessing the actual physical incidents in her mind's eye. They decided to call the police who used the detailed descriptions of the murder given by the eight year-old (the time, the weapon, the place, the clothes he wore, what the little girl he killed had said to him) to find and convict the man in question.

This was a complete and verified PE memory. It could have been run and cleared using Hypnoetics™!

If you have the opportunity to help in such a case, simply engage with the organ part by talking to it directly. Ask its story and process it, just like any other memory episode. It will be very like a past life memory. Expect a dialogue and you will get it. If there is any interference from the case in front of you, ask him or her if they would mind stepping aside while you talk to the part. He or she will need to relay your instructions to the organ telepathically, as it were.

If you are able to work on a case in this way, you will have made a start in understanding the multi-part nature of “self” described in chapter 15 as “The Complex Of Self.”

## ANCESTRAL CURSES

You may be familiar with the concept that certain families seem to be some sort of a ‘jinx’ (for the want of a better word) of accidents, disasters, setbacks and untimely and sudden deaths, sometimes stretching back a few hundred years.

These are basically protoplasm shadows or imprints, playing out. In other words, genetic memories. These are very real and you will encounter them frequently, once you know to be alert for them.

There may be a legend or tradition that Wild Minnie of the Clan Fergus laid a curse on great great great Uncle Rory! It runs down through the generations.

We take the implanting of the curse as a legitimate episode, get the time and place and process it (it would run like a past life, of course).

Many tribes and races take curses very seriously. Voodoo is big business in the Caribbean, for example. There are many reported instances, which check out authentically, where a malevolent person has cast a curse on someone and it comes to pass. What is not so easy to disentangle is whether or not it is sub-consciously made to come true by the person who is the target and believes in the power of the curse; or whether there is the possibility of real psychic force that overrides an individual’s auto-determinism.

Really, too much is made of curses, taboos, and malevolent beings, ghosts, wicked monsters, voodoo, devils and the like. They have NO POWER whatever over a person, except the power that is invested in them by the person who chooses to believe these things can affect him or her.

If you are afraid and believe such a thing could hurt you... guess what? You can be hurt! But if you utterly reject such a possibility (you should) then another’s intentions cannot harm you.

Bottom line? A curse does not take its power from the wisher or giver; a curse takes ALL its power from the target or victim.

# PARENTAL DYSFUNCTIONALITY

Don't get this idea of charge and aberration passed down through the generations mixed up with parental stupidity and ignorance...

The sad fact is that parents pass their crap down to their children, who pass it to their children, etc. Whatever issues the parents have, the child is in danger of acquiring the same, sometimes even before the child can think properly and independently.

I can reveal something even more interesting; it needs further research and development. But about 10 years ago Vivien and I were investigating the effects of voice re-patterning, along the lines of Alfred Tomatis' work. We used a device called the Vo-Cal 360, developed by inventor Calvin Young.

What we found repeatedly was that it was not so much the parents that "imprinted" on the child, as Freud claimed. It was the grandparents.

Grandfather is a big deal in North American Indian lore; Chinese tradition too. After this insight, I am inclined to believe these old and venerable wisdoms more than Freud!

Of course parents are important. But in later piloting, we have developed the technique of interviewing the client about his or her grandparents. And you know what's amazing? The person doesn't even need to have met the grandparent. Maybe he or she died long before the child was even born. But you can ask: "What do you know about your father's father?" and so on, through all four figures. You will get interesting answers and the GSR meter will respond.

You will find events from the past and, yes, you will know and see enough in your mind's eye to process these as your own memories. We call this trans-personal memory and Stanislav Grof researched it thoroughly and wrote a book you may enjoy: *Beyond The Brain* (1985).

Yes, parents are often bad news. But where did they get their "stuff" from? Their parents, of course, and so on, back through the generations.

I have yet to ascertain for certain this is the way to go in order to disconnect everyone from their ancestral garbage via the PE (hopefully without disconnecting them from ancestral wisdom). But if I am right, we have a way at last of stopping the passing on of stupidity, wild emotions, dysfunctional behaviors and all the other human curses! Many workers have tried to solve this problem. SOMEBODY has to solve it, otherwise civilization is going nowhere.

# MIASMS

A miasm is one of the most powerful influences in health and disease I know, yet the least acknowledged or understood. The word was introduced by Samuel Hahnemann, the father of homeopathy, but I prefer to think of a 'genetic toxin', since that gives a far clearer idea of what we think we are dealing with. Basically a miasm means a shadow or disease 'imprint' which is inherited down the generations.

All acutely observant doctors are aware that disease and disturbance tends to run in families. It can be likened to a kind of family blight. This is not to mean a specific replicated genetic disorder carried by the genes like, for example, haemophilia or Freidrich's ataxia. The sickliness can manifest itself in various ways, each individual suffering differently from the others in his or her family tree but all bound by the commonality of being a somewhat weakened or unhealthy bunch, because of the miasm.

This idea may seem to be an attempt to revive Lamarck's discredited theory of evolution, which said that an organism's responses to environmental stressors could be passed on to offspring. This is now held not to be true; the Darwinian/Mendelian dogma reigns, that only the factors carried in the genes can be inherited. But that's wrong, basically!

To Hahnemann a miasm was something more in the nature of a primitive illness, a throwback. He named three in particular: *Syphilis*, *Sycosis* and *Psora*. Briefly, syphilis (or *Luesinum*) has ulcerating tendencies; *sycosis* or *Medorrhinum* (meaning from gonorrhoea) is congestive, leading to deposits and tumor formation; while *psora* (*Psorinum*) is a protean disturbance that relates to functional imbalances of all kinds.

Antoine Nebel and Henry C Allen added *Tuberculinum*, which many practitioners now regard as the pre-eminent miasm; indeed it is still troubling us today and TB has begun a comeback, despite antibiotics. Among the fall-out diseases from this inherited toxin one can list asthma, eczema, hay fever, food allergies, chronic sinusitis, migraines, mental illness of various kinds, irritable bowel, colitis, heart trouble, diabetes, Hodgkin's disease and even leukemia.

Leon Vannier added a fifth, which is the *oncotic* (cancer) miasm. It is characterized by changes in body odour, warts, excrescences, sores that refuse to heal and a sallow skin, somewhat like that of malignant cachexia.

All this will rightly cause you to think of the possibility of unhappy psychological states also being caused by miasms. You would not be wrong.

Be on the alert for miasms adding difficulties to the person's psychological case, especially the protoplasm entity. See, even though miasms are energetic or even non-material, it is the physical body that is disturbed; the creature.

It would be heading in the wrong direction to blame the theta being.

As an example of how miasmata (the plural) indirectly impinge on our work, consider a person who is angry and bites, which suggests the *Syphilinum (Luesinum)* miasm. He is orally fixated according to Freud's theory.

Samuel Hahnemann described *psora* as characterized by the feeling that we are small, weak, unable to succeed in the face of a challenge, overwhelmed by the demands that life makes on us. It is the feeling of lack—lack of strength, stamina, power, or whatever else it takes to survive. *Psora* is the influence that makes us feel we can never have enough money, comfort, belongings, or love.

It can help to administer the miasm, before wasting scores of piloting hours addressing those very issues!

## BIOLOGICAL FUNCTION OF THE PE

In the end, the genetic or Protoplasm Entity has a job to do. It's there as a compilation of ancestral memories, to guide, help and protect you. We are not in the job of trying to override Nature's positive mechanisms.

What we are seeking to do it spread the light of truth, so there are no dark unknowns. And in doing so, we disconnect the vicious override mechanisms by which remote and now-worthless reactive or reductionist memories are forced into the current thinking train, where they have no positive value but are counter-productive.

Instinct is one thing. But conditioned reflexes, enforced by experiences that took place long ago and now have no relevance, are the very curse of human nature!

Wilhelm Reich, who orthodox medicine is pleased to describe as "discredited", had one abiding idea (no, not orgone). It was the Emotional Plague. In Reich's view this was the number one disease which threatened Mankind.

Look around you—and at past history—and take a note of the outcomes of all fear, rages, hatred and intolerance. The Emotional Plague has killed hundreds

of millions, through acts of violence, destruction and war. Throw in famine (through selfishness and stupidity) and economic deprivation (through greed and stupidity), environmental damage (through ignorance and stupidity) and you will readily admit that Mankind's emotional ineptness and passion for irrationality has, indeed, cost many billions of lives.

There's a lot to write about on this topic. For the meantime, just fully flatten whatever you find, whether it is psychic memory or residues in the PE.

## PUNK POINTS

- However "spiritual" you want to be and however clever you rate yourself at psychic abilities, it's all for nothing if you neglect the body. Rejecting the flesh is very foolish and ignorant. The truth is, that the physical is as much "you" as the theta being.
- As we progress up the ladder with Supernoetics® renewal, we emerge more and more as a powerful spiritual entity. We are gloriously magnificent in this state. Wonder and awe are too slight-ish words to even begin to express it.
- Yet we are also "creature". It's the lowest level of thinking. But it's still real. The "creature", or what I here call the Protoplasm Entity (PE), is still going to serve up unpleasant emotions, daft behaviors, appetites and obsessions of all kinds (sexual, not the least of these). Unless you work with and alongside your "creature" and cherish it you'll be very uncomfortable indeed.
- Think of the PE like a thoroughbred animal. You would stroke it, love it and care for it. Feed it well; get it the best veterinary care; exercise it; put it out to stud maybe! Thoroughbreds are enormously valuable. Don't mistreat yours.
- Learn to step back or, as we say, go "upstairs" and see yourself being yourself when emotions get too strong. From on high you can calm, soothe and even advise the creature. You are NOT your emotions. You are NOT your behaviors. You are not even your thoughts. You are the point of knowing and awareness at the heart of everything that matters.
